

Now, I know God, I am happy, and I am very happy to be baptized. I am 15 years old, and I was born in the Dominican Republic. Because I am a Haitian it is very difficult for me to live in this country but with God all is possible. Even though my father is dead, God gives me strength and now God is my father. He is everything to me."

Miquel, the 12-year-old pastors son said, "I was born in the church and since I was little, I have been a Christian. A few days after I was born, I was dedicated to the Lord. I have been raised in the Gospel, and I feel good to have been raised that way. You may ask, why have I stayed in the Gospel?
