"...let us not be weary in well doing, for in due season we shall reap, if we faint not." (Galatians 6:9)

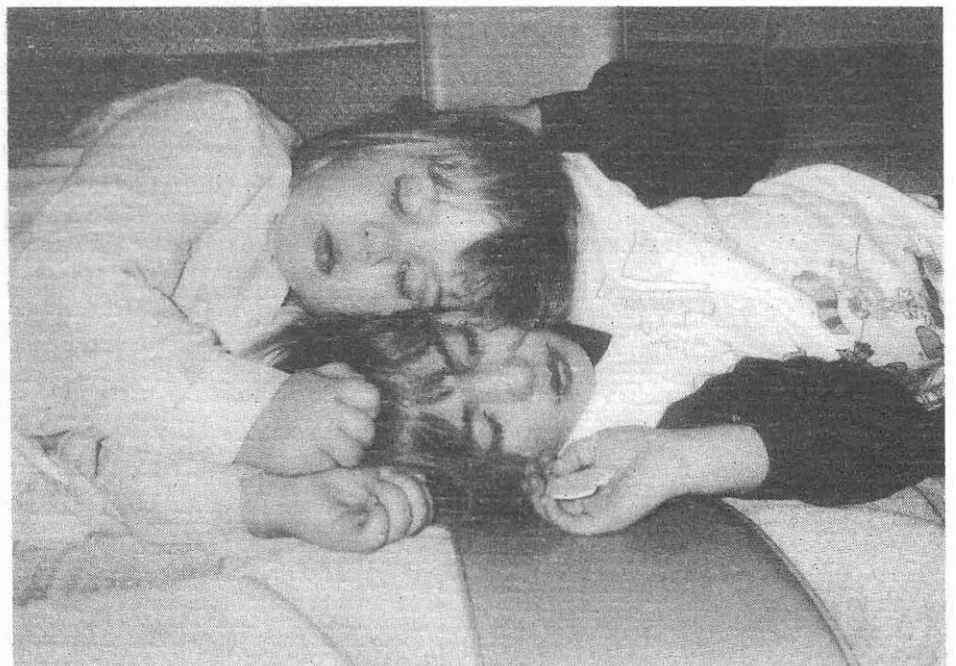
Can you believe it? In just a few days from the time you receive this letter we will be crossing the Rio Grande into Mexico!
