Still others attempt to contact the dead through mediums. We praise the Lord that the Gospel opened the eyes of a young mother and a boy, who received Jesus Christ as Savior.

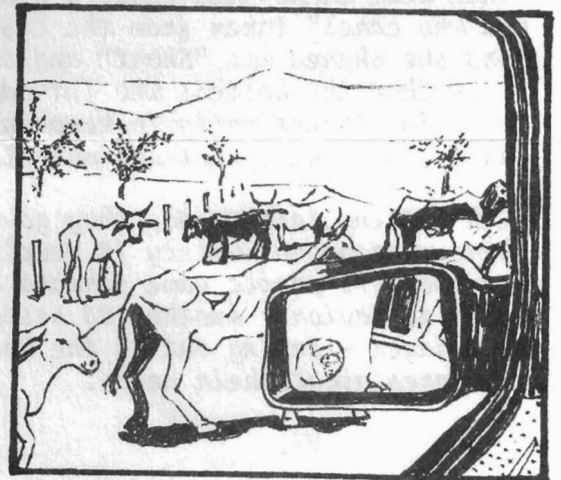
