

The Honduran airforce, located next door, looked like fossilized WWII aircraft unable to crank the engine, let alone get airborne.

My first, second and remaining impression of the Honduran people is that they are a gentle race who speak Spanish with a slight Italian accent. Once they are behind the wheel of a car, they like to honk their horns a lot and see how many pedestrians they can run over. One morning a Honduran pastor picked me up. The traffic in the main street was moving at a snails's pace, so he jumped the curb & drove his mini van down the sidewalk for several hundred yards until he turned down a less congested street. That was not the first time I saw that, and no-one seemed to mind, including the pastor's wife!
