
CUBA UPDATE:

African Subversives attack ministry team partner. No one is harmed. Fidel Castro's training grounds for foreign revolutionaries is located on the Island of the Pines. Kevin Godwin head of our video production was video taping outside of a shopping compound on this island. Suddenly a group of black men began shouting at him and swinging their fists.


Immediately, I jumped out of the van and ran to rescue Kevin. Thrusting myself between Kevin and the angry men I repeated over and over again "lo siento, lo siento mucho (we are sorry, we are very sorry)." In the same breath I turned to Kevin and said "get in the van, NOW!". I soon realized the raging men were shouting in English with a thick African accent saying "you do not have permission to take our picture...".

I apologized and apologized (this time in English) and headed for the van. Then the Africans turned to the crowd of bystanders and tried to incite a riot. I called for the taxi driver to get us out of there! Our driver said the Africans were afraid that if their government got a hold of that video they would be executed.

IMPRISONED AND TORTURED TO DEATH:

"I Raul Soto Piedra was here for nine years in this prison hell. I have been beaten (on numerous occasions) almost to death. I have left my finger prints in this place in order to let everyone that comes after me know what is in store for them. I trust in God. The government of our time has oppressed us... The land shall not be destroyed. He who trusts in God shall abide for ever. The Lord shall not destroy the nation that repents. 1976 "

These words are inscribed on the wall of a tiny six by eight foot, double occupancy, cell. From the inside looking out of this circular prison one can see two towers (smoke stacks). This is where political prisoners, many of whom were Christians, were tortured to death and their bodies incinerated. This same prison today stands as a museum in honor of Fidel Castro. Who he himself was incarcerated here for nearly two years after his failed attempt to over throw the former Cuban dictatorship on July 26, 1953.
