### Dear Friends,


January 16th, at 6:10 in the evening, I was setting up my video projector in my home church here in Mexico. Suddenly, I was told that the war had begun. I was called to pray in a back room. As I entered, I saw Mexican people weeping, prostrate on the ground, praying for the United States of America.

They gathered the four American citizens present together: two teen-age girls there for short term mission work; Javier, an American-born Mexican who speaks a few words in English; and myself. They prayed, and prayed, and prayed.

We moved into the main sanctuary, and began the evening service during which they called the church to pray. They prayed for the destruction of Saddam Hussein, the peace of Jerusalem, and that God would spare the lives of the Multi national force. They prayed that the war would end quickly. We sang songs that said that the Lord is victorious over his enemies. Leaders of the church shared words to comfort and give courage.

The pastor asked me if I had something to share with the church, but I was still numb with the news and believe it or not, I had nothing to say. Later, after praying with my Mexican brothers, I began to think about those that would die in the fighting without knowing Christ. I shared with them some of my reflections on the war and the times in which we are living and gave an invitation to recieve Christ. Approximately 20 people of all ages came forward.
