

Pray for us, that the Word of the Lord may have free course in Mexico.

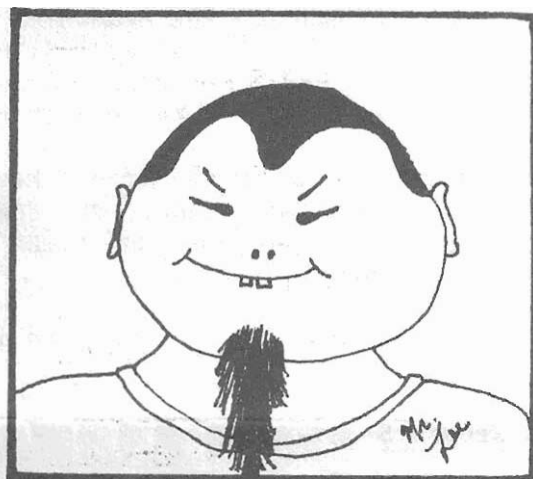
Dear Friends,

You may wonder how I can communicate with people of such diverse language backgrounds. Let me tell you a little secret. It helps to be fluent in English.

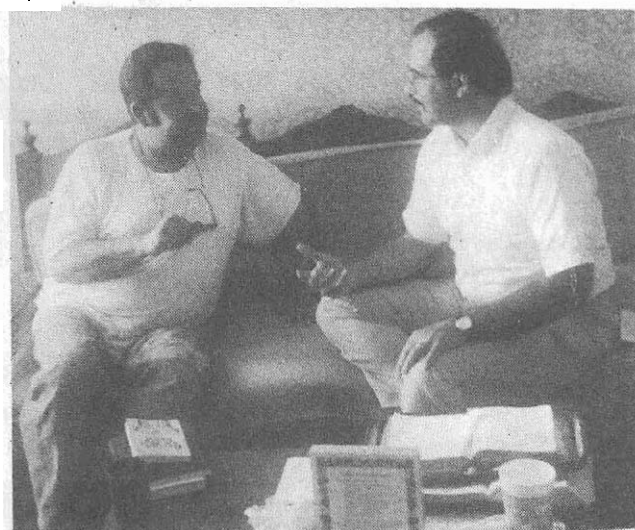
The gentleman from Peru's name is Dante. We have just spent the better part of 2 days together in counsel and teaching. He is especially interested in learning about the power of the Holy Spirit in helping him to overcome his current problems. Please pray for him! Without divulging his current situation, he gave me permission to share a little of his background. He was raised in spiritualism, the pagan occult practices of much of South America. He told me stories that would make your skin crawl:

He found Jesus Christ as his saviour while searching the Bible for himself. He then studied the Bible for 4 years in a traditional denominational school that did not believe in the resurrection, Virgin Birth, Heaven, hell, the devil, or the miracles of Jesus. He was swept into the teaching of Liberation Theology and served working in social programs. This led to a lot of confusion as he sincerely desires to know the truth and be used of the Lord to reach his people with the Gospel.

LIGHTS -- PROJECTOR -- ACTION!!

We are now entering a new dimension of ministry concentrating on evangelism and outreach. We will be working with Mexican youth to reach the lost. Our methods of evangelism will be Christian films, (in Spanish), music, drama, track distribution, and preaching. We hope to reach souls in the city, ranches, and pueblos.

In order to carry out the Great Commission in this way, we need the tools to get the job done. The first thing we need is a used truck with heavy suspension that can take the rough terrain and carry a lot of weight (young people and equipment). I hope to be able to purchase it this summer before we leave the States. Our preference is a Dodge maxi van with a 318 engine. This will be functional and economical to operate (approx. \$4,000).

The second thing needed is a Sony HP-32 VHS projector. You may ask why a VHS and not an old 16mm projector. The reason is that to buy a 16mm Christian movie costs between \$600 to \$3,000 and a VHS cassette film costs between \$39 to \$79. This makes it financially feasible to purchase films for evangelism. This projector costs about \$750 plus shipping, which is less than the cost of one 16mm film.

The third large piece of equipment needed at this time will be a 1500 watt generator to operate the projector, lights, and sound equipment. Whether new or used is not important as long as it is dependable and quiet running. My guess is that we can get a used generator for under \$1,000.

Please pray and ask the Lord to help us to obtain this needed equipment.

OTHER REQUESTS

1. That those who have received Christ through this ministry will be established in the faith.
2. That we find housing as we take our next step in ministry
3. That God guides and protects us as we visit the churches this summer.

We really appreciate your prayers, because the Lord hears them. While renewing our visas our van broke down in the desert. There just happened to be a mechanic stopped on the side of the road to take out the broken thermostat. P.T.L.!
