

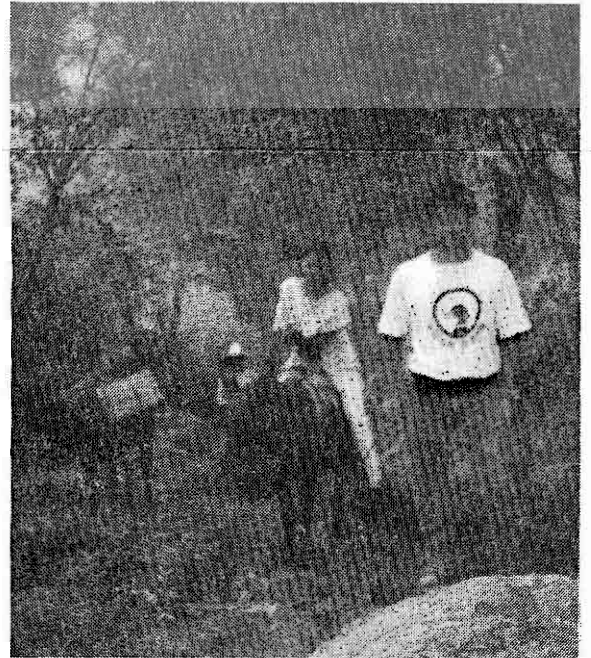

Dear Friends,

There were ten pastors without any Bible training until now. The rustic little town of El Puerto, Queretero has become another Bible training center for VIDA, inc. This obscure town is now the hub of pastoral training for several mountain villages where the people do not enjoy the luxuries of running water or electricity. Some of these remote locations are not even connected by roads, just by paths meandering through the mountains. Among one of these isolated villages is Tangojo. This community has a population of about 500 people. The majority of the people have embraced the Gospel, but their pastor has never received any Bible training anywhere. Now, he is walking three hours one way to attend the classes in El Puerto.

I rushed Carol to the doctors house to get a shot. Even with the injection, she remained in pain all night. It's at moments like this that one must know that the Lord has called us here and will keep us.

With diagnosis ranging from brain damage to Optic Neuritis, Lee's eye problem was pinpointed to a leakage of fluid in his retina, causing the distorted vision in his left eye. The doctor said that there is a chance that it may heal itself without laser surgery. Believe with us for a miracle.
