EL S A L V A D O




I arrived in the capitol city, San Salvador that evening as the news flooded in that the ex-CEO of Taca Airlines, Federico Bloch was murdered by three men. This was a great tragedy for this tiny Central American nation. Taca is one of the few highly visible first rate international companies of El Salvador. If that wasn't enough, on day two and three, the drama continued, with rioting in the streets. The communist party was holding demonstration rallies in protest of the newly elected democratic administration. It did not take long before violence erupted and things were out of control. The organized mobs turned over and torched a news vehicle, destroyed public telephones and threw stones at police. Someone commented to me that this is how the war that lasted nearly three decades began, with sporadic outbreaks of violence.

One evening, after a day of riots, we drove over the broken glass on the torched streets on our way to minister at an evangelistic meeting. It was interdenominational and intentional, with one purpose to bring friends, neighbors and family members to Christ. We had a wonderful dress-up, sit down dinner accompanied by Christian music and testimonies before a message. I was able to share a fifteen minute testimony. We had a good response. Out of the approximate 150 people in a attendance about 12 came forward and another 2 dozen for prayer. The name of this grass roots organization is "*Ministry Of Jesus Christ, Specialist In The Impossible!*"

Pedro Garcia, former 700 club's point man for El Salvador, the son of a preacher, now is Vida Internacional's new representative. He pulled together a national conference for the promotion of our Bible

The conference was held at the University of Andres Bello. We had around two hundred in attendance. There was a great contrast of different socio-economic and cultural levels represented. We had Government officials, community leaders, Pastors, church leaders, non profits and private foundations represented. They expressed genuine interest in our Bible School.
