Antonio, age 10, and Manuel, age 14, live at the dump. They don't even remember what their mother, father, or siblings look like. They were abandoned by their parents, and later taken in by their grandparents. Grandma and Grandpa died, and they were passed between relatives. Manuel and Antonio long to know their brothers and sisters. Manuel has never gone to school, and is unable to read or write. Antonio can only see shadows out of his right eye. He needs an operation to improve his chances of seeing.

Afraid and hiding in a closet at the church, Maria De Los Angeles is heavy with child. She was afraid that her common law husband, a drunkard, would beat her for being at church. I talked her out of the closet to find that her family lives on top of the dump in a house made out of trash. Her son, Eduardo is two, Jaqueline is five. One day some ladies from the church bathed Jaqueline and picked the gum and trash from her matted hair. They took off the rags she was wearing, and put on clean clothes. The ladies then took her home and asked her mother if this was her child. Three times Maria said she did not know her. This little girl does not live here.... Jaqueline shouted, MOMMY it's me!! Jaqueline now sings praises and worships her God... Who will never abandon her. Even if her mother and father forsake her.
